What is Pregnant and Parenting Teen Support Services?

BBF-ECS Pregnant & Parenting Teen Support Services is composed of a comprehensive, integrated system of early health, academic and family support services to support pregnant and parenting teens and their children. This program will provide an array of services to support young men and women who have not yet graduated from high school and who are currently expecting a child or are parenting a child 0-5 years old. Services include, but are not limited to: pregnancy testing, pregnancy counseling and support, parenting classes, programs for dads, child birth education, play groups, tutoring, study groups, incentive programs and more.

Who is eligible for referral?

Eligible clients are pregnant and parenting teens of low income in Douglas and Sarpy Counties who have not yet graduated from high school.

Who is providing services?

BBF-ECS Pregnant and Parenting Teen Support Services is a collaborative effort among several local agencies providing a variety of services to pregnant and parenting teens. All services are confidential and free of charge.
