Building Bright Futures will conduct the sessions to explain the competitive application process and discuss programmatic details for projects that increase the number of students served in Douglas and Sarpy Counties and to improve the quality of mentoring programs in these counties. Awards will be made to successful applicants who submit proposals to one of two funding streams: Capacity Building grants and Expansion grants.
